- Ezer Mizion's collaboration with the Israeli army enables every IDF recruit to join the registry as part of their enlistment process






International Bone Marrow Donor Registry

In 1998, Ezer Mizion established its bone marrow donor registry with the goal of enriching the international pool with potential bone marrow donors for specific, underrepresented ethnicities and unique genetic combinations.

Ezer Mizion's registry is a lifesaving resource wherever an unrelated stem cell donor is needed around the world. No one is immune to cancer and 10% of cancer patients will need a bone marrow or stem cell transplant as a therapy protocol. The registry is a safety net for humanity.


